

Troop 181 Sign-up Package

1. **Scout Application** – required for every youth.
2. **Adult Volunteer Application** – we ask that at least one parent volunteer to participate in the troop as an Assistant Scoutmaster or Committee Member.
3. **Consent To Treat Form** – required before a Scout can attend a campout.
4. **Class 1 and 2 Medical Form** – required before a Scout or Adult under 40 years old can attend a campout longer than 72 hours.
5. **Class 3 Medical Form** - only required for adults over the age of 40 who will be going on campouts longer than 72 hours or anyone who is attending a High Adventure camp.
6. **Automobile Insurance Information Form** - this form is required if you will be transporting Scouts to events.
7. **Troop Behavior Guidelines** - this form should be read and signed by every youth.
8. **Fees** – checks can be made payable to Troop 181
 - \$60 – annual Troop dues for each Scout
 - \$10 – Boy Scout registration fee for each youth application
 - \$10 – Boy Scout registration fee for each adult application
 - \$12 – Boys Life magazine subscription (optional)
9. **Required Uniform Supplies** - needed for youths and Assistant Scoutmasters

New Scout Uniform Supply Bundle

New Scouts joining Troop 181 will need to purchase the following items from the troop supply chairman. We recommend that these items are purchased at the same time the troop dues and BSA registration is paid. These items are typically delivered at the time of Crossover.
